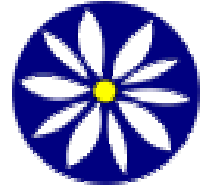

The last financial year ending 30<sup>th</sup> September 2002 was a great success with over £23,000 being raised for The Anthony Nolan Trust. I would like to express my sincere thanks to all the supporters who made this possible.

Our new financial year started on the 1<sup>st</sup> October 2002 with a Dinner & Dance at The Limes Hotel, Needham Market. Thanks go to all who attended and who donated draw prizes.

This year's programme will include two new events to get your adrenalin rushing. They will be a 25 & 45 mile cycle ride around the historical villages of Suffolk, starting at Hadleigh, Suffolk, on Sunday 25<sup>th</sup> May. Build your leg power up for this.
